	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Essentially a social network analysis tool ○ Used to measure how organizations/agencies within STEP are working together, to assess where and how STEP can and should strengthen their partnerships, and to chart progress in the relationships and activities of STEP ○ Identifies the members of a network and the relationships between those members (cooperative, coordinated, integrated) ○ Data collection will take place from Dec. 7-21st <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 20 question survey, to be completed online via email invitation ○ 2016 PARTNER results <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Majority of organizations were government or community based (27% and 23% respectively) ▪ 43% of relationships involved cooperative activities, 26% involved coordinated activities, and 19% involved integrated activities ▪ Participants reported an overall trust level of 77% ▪ Achievements as a result of PARTNER: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coordinated communication, improved resource sharing, increased access to services for youth and parents/guardians, healthier environments for youth, and reduction of health disparities
